

When a CMYK+ press can **print six colors in a single pass and handle a large variety of substrates**, you can affordably produce novel pieces that appeal to multiple senses.

Inkjet

The pressures of shorter, more frequent runs aren't going to relent anytime soon. To keep these jobs profitable, you need **affordable variable color**, enabled by production inkjet printing systems. Inkjet technology is a critical answer to meeting the needs of smarter, more flexible print—to absorb last-minute changes, add variable text and graphics, and have sufficient production capacity to meet customers' volume and cost needs.



Enhancements in inks, heads, coatings, and a broader range of substrates are now available in cutsheet and continuous feed inkjet presses, which means the advantages of inkjet have finally hit the tipping point. New devices have entered the market that support standard coated commercial paper grades, thicker paper, as well as higher resolution output that rivals the image quality of sheet-fed toner-based systems and offset.



The large format market skyrocketed in 2020 and continues to rise: the global large format display market size is estimated to reach \$13.1 billion in 2021. This means print businesses have found new ways to maximize the capabilities of their large format presses; health and safety floor and wall graphics were just the beginning of this upward trend. The large format space has entered a long-term cycle of growth as innovators push past posters, signs, and banners and enter exciting new areas, from home and commercial décor to custom packaging. Inline

Inline finishing solutions can eliminate touches in a run and greatly reduce the need for operator oversight. An analyst for InfoTrends reported that interviews with more than 100 print customers demonstrated "an appetite and a willingness" on their part to pay premiums of 24% to 89% over CMYK-only printing for print enhancements. Combining this appetite with automated, inline finishing/bindery options for digital production presses means **jobs that deliver customer delight and profit** at the same time.
